# Can you help Ronan and Ramona with their spending plan?

Ramona and Ronan earn \$30 at their pizza stand. That means they should put \$6 in savings for Stinkland, but an ice cream truck stops nearby. What should they do?





Rainy weather means the pizza stand hasn't had many customers. Ronan and Ramona only make \$8, so they only have \$1 to save toward their goal. Should they save it or spend it, since it's less than they planned to save?



Ramona and Ronan want to buy new t-shirts to advertise the pizza stand. The shirts cost \$10, which would have to come out of their savings. Should they buy them?



Ronan and Ramona are about a month away from having enough money for Stinkland tickets, but Ronan's skateboard needs a new wheel. Should he buy it now or wait until after he and Ramona have gone to Stinkland?
