Teacher Tip: Throughout this guide there will be a highlight or "Big Idea" this is the main takeaway that all students should have after the lesson.


The vocabulary terms **Goods vs. Services** might be challenging for some students. Continue to reinforce the difference between the two. A good is something consumable. They can touch it, see it, feel it, taste it (think the 5 senses). A service is an action someone does for a person, a house painter, a fireman, a teacher. Use the attached flashcards to help distinguish between the two terms. Print out the vocabulary cards and put on a key ring to continue to reinforce concepts.

There are three levels of activities in order to meet the needs of all learners. Level A is the most complex. Level C is the least complex.
