



Grade 3 Lesson 2

Pizza Topping Shopping



Learning Outcomes:

(What are our success criteria for the lesson?)

Students understand:

- Their financial decisions impact other options
- Prioritizing helps create better decisions
- The concept of trade-offs
- The concept of prioritizing wants

Materials:

(What do I need for this lesson?)

- Pizza Topping Shopping handout for each student

Instructions *(What steps do I take to run this lesson?)*

Activity

1. Provide each student with a *Pizza Topping Shopping Handout*.
2. Explain to the students that in this game, they have been given a budget of \$10 to make their very own pizza. Each ingredient has a different cost, so they will have to think very carefully about what they really want on their pizza.
3. Instruct students to start selecting the ingredients for the pizza. Explain that they should circle the ingredients they want to buy for their pizza.
4. Point out that pizzas must have pizza dough and pizza sauce, otherwise it won't be a pizza.
5. Explain that once they've finished circling the ingredients they want, they should add up the cost of the ingredients.
6. Finally, explain that they should answer the questions at the bottom of the worksheet.

Learning Check *(How can I know what my students are thinking?)*

Ask the following questions at various stages to help you understand what your students are thinking:

- ¿Crees que podrías hacer una pizza que te gustara si solo tuvieras seis dólares?
- ¿Qué tipo de pizza harías si cada ingrediente solo costará un dólar?



Folleto para el estudiante - Ingredientes para pizza y compras
